



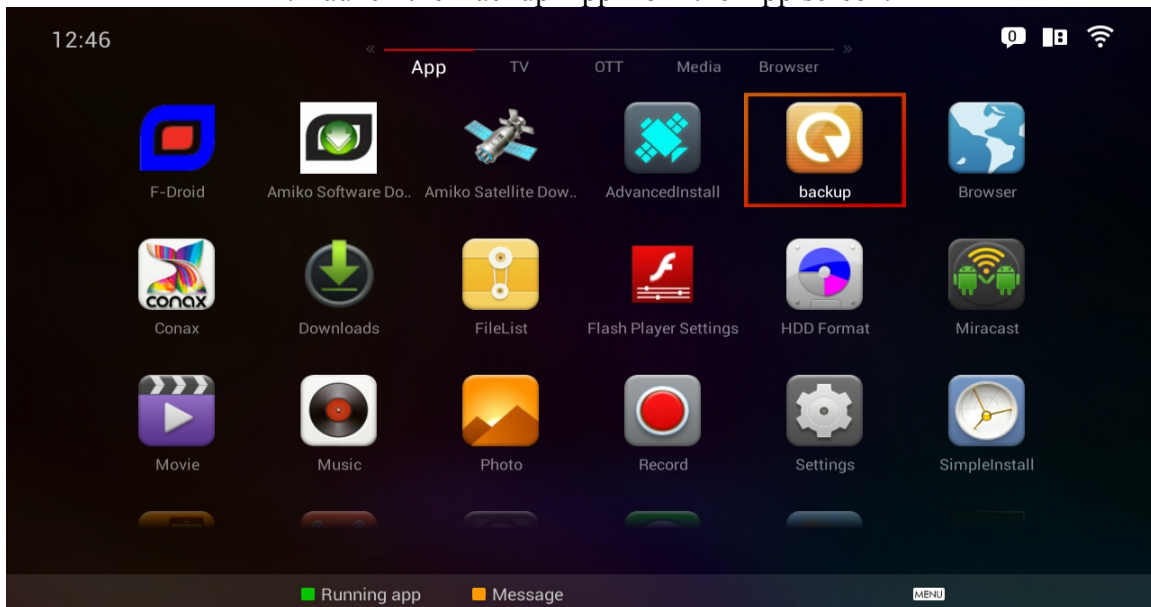
HOW AND WHAT TO BACKUP ON YOUR A3

Your Amiko A3 contains a simple but powerful backup utility. With the Backup App you can quickly back up your satellite/channel data, userapps and data. In the event that you corrupt userdata, reset the STB or accidentally delete your Apps you can restore everything with the press of a few keys.

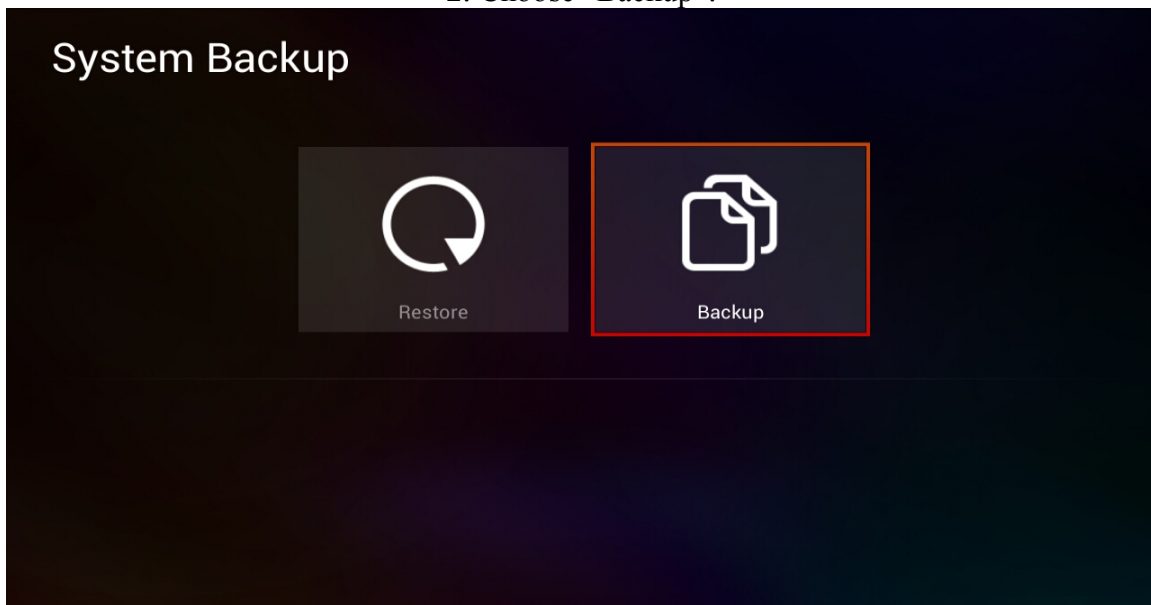
It is important to note that several of the Apps and utilities on your A3 (like our Appstore, software downloader, sat downloader etc) are userapps. This means you can delete them and they are not part of the ROM (software) updates. The only way to restore these Apps is from your own backup.

A USB flash drive or microSD card is recommended for backups.

1. Launch the Backup App from the App screen.

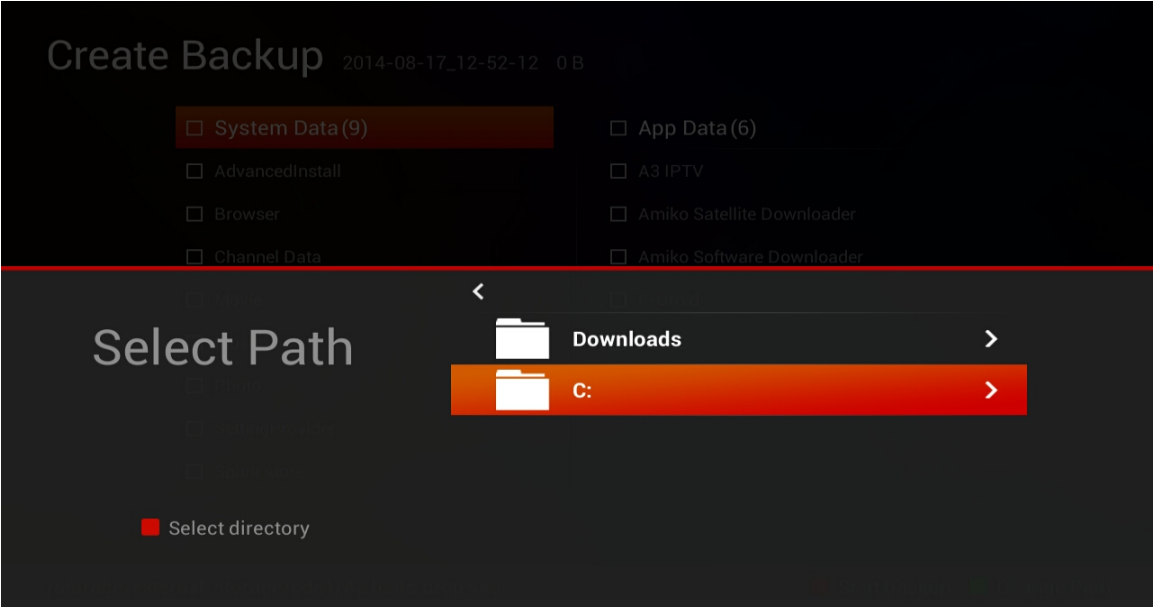


2. Choose "Backup".

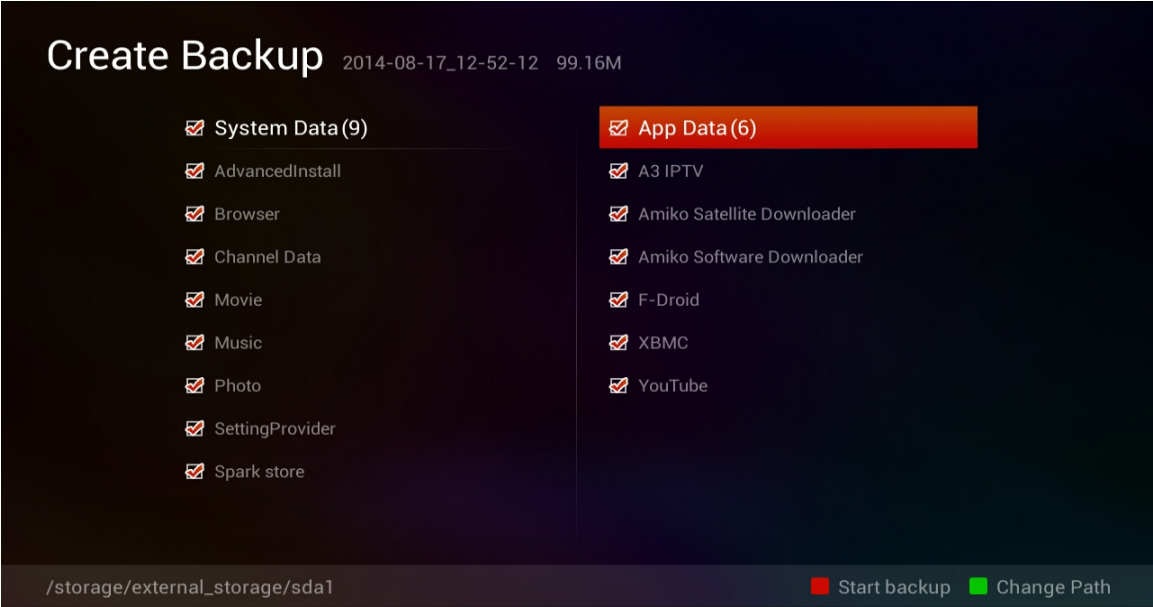




3. Choose backup location. If it does not prompt you for this you can change it by pressing GREEN key. USB or microSD card is recommended, do not use the virtual Downloads drive. When your selection is highlighted press RED key.

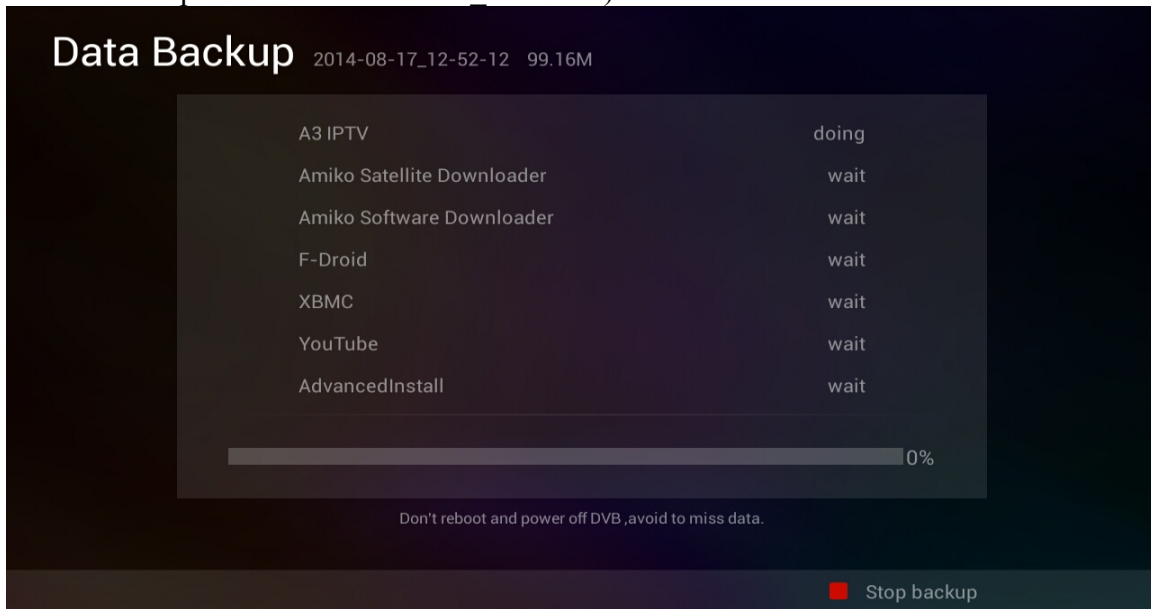


4. Choose what to back up. It is highly recommended that you choose everything from both lists so you have a complete backup. When restoring you can pick and choose single items such as the channel list to restore on their own. After selecting what you want press RED key to start.





5. A3 will start the backup and report progress. When done it will exit to the first Restore/Backup screen. A folder (in this example named 2014-08-17_12-52-12) created on the drive/location selected.



6. Restore is an identical process to the above except you choose “Restore” from the first screen in the Backup App.
