All three components
must be DISH Pro Plus:



It Takes 3!

- DISH Pro Plus Technology allows a DISH Pro Plus (dual-tuner) receiver to be connected to a DISH Pro Plus switch or DISH Pro Plus LNBF using one cable, when used with a DISH Pro Plus Separator.
- All three of the following **MUST** be used for the single-cable, dual-tuner installation, and must be connected together:
 1. A DISH Pro Plus Switch or DISH Pro Plus LNBF
 2. A DISH Pro Plus Separator
 3. A DISH Pro Plus (dual-tuner) receiver

Frequently Asked Questions

1. *Can I connect two single-tuner receivers (like ViP211, DISH Player-DVR 510, etc.) to a DISH Pro Plus Separator for the single-cable installation?*

NO! The two receivers are DISH Pro, not DISH Pro Plus (dual-tuner) receivers.

Remember: It Takes 3
DISH Pro Plus components.

2. *Can I connect a DP Plus Separator to DISH Pro LNBF or Switch and use that with a DISH Pro Plus receiver for the single-cable installation?*

NO! A DP Plus Separator must be connected between a DISH Pro Plus LNBF or Switch and a DISH Pro Plus receiver.

DISH Pro Plus components.
